

## The Fundamentals Behind CBTp

Online training

NYC CBTp is excited to launch their first online course in the Fundamentals Behind CBT for psychosis. CBT for psychosis (CBTp) is an evidence-based treatment, commonly available in Europe, and recommended by best practice guidelines in both the US and the UK. This course will cover key principals that underlie CBTp and is beneficial to both licensed clinicians as a foundational component of their work towards accreditation in CBTp and to front line and milieu staff looking to increase their knowledge and skills in working with people with psychosis and reduce their job-related burnout.

**Who can attend:** anybody working with psychosis in a professional capacity (this training is **not** for family members or friends).

**Training format:**

The training will be entirely online and on demand.

**Learning Objectives:**

By the end of this online training participants will be able to:

1. Summarize what is psychosis, listing typical symptoms and possible diagnoses that include these
2. Explain the concept of psychosis as part of the spectrum of normal human experience
3. Demonstrate increased empathy for voice hearing and delusions by applying at least one empathy generating exercise
4. Describe the concept of “working within a delusional belief system” and be able to recite one reason why we do it

**Teaching methods:**

The workshop will include didactic material, interactive exercises, video material, quizzes and discussion.

**Successful completion:**

In order to successfully complete this online training and be eligible for CE credits participants must:

- Review the material from all 5 modules
- Watch every slide and video to the end
- Complete all quizzes and evaluations
- Post comments to discussion where requested
- Score 70% or higher for evaluation quizzes
- Complete and submit the Continuing Education evaluation and feedback form at the end of the workshop

**About the Instructor:**

Dr Sally E. Riggs, DClInPsy is a licensed psychologist and expert in Cognitive Behavioral Therapy for

Psychosis with 19 years of experience working in this field in both London, UK and the US. She earned her Doctorate in clinical psychology at Royal Holloway, University of London, UK in 2005, where she was trained in CBTp. She completed her Postdoctoral Research Fellowship at the Aaron T. Beck Psychopathology Research Unit, University of Pennsylvania, during which she designed and facilitated a program to train Masters, Bachelors and Peer-level therapists working in a city community agency in CBT informed interventions for the psychosis milieu. From 2011 to 2015, at Kings County Hospital Center, Brooklyn, she spearheaded a CBT for psychosis treatment track in the Adult Outpatient Department, trained the Early Psychosis Inpatient unit in CBT informed interventions for the psychosis milieu, and trained and supervised clinical staff throughout the hospital in Full CBTp. She founded NYC CBTp in March 2016 to provide evidence-based psychotherapy for psychosis to people throughout the city, and to widen the availability of her training programs to clinicians throughout the tri-state area.
